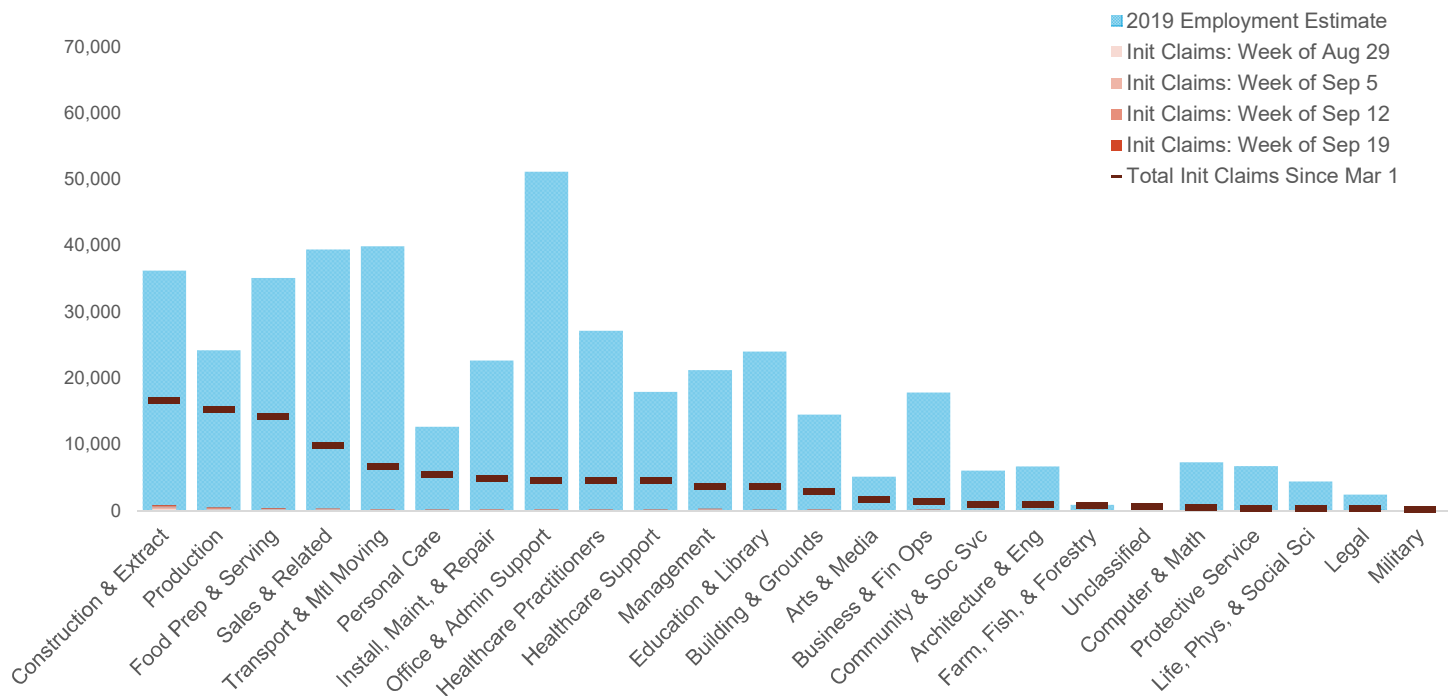


# EMPLOYMENT & INITIAL UNEMPLOYMENT CLAIMS BY OCCUPATION GROUP

**OCCUPATION** refers to the type of work an employee does. Employees may work for the same employer (e.g. a hospital) but belong to different occupation groups due to the nature of their respective work (e.g. nurse, accountant, custodian).

**INITIAL CLAIMS** are the count of unemployment claims started in a given week. This data does not account for claims that continue to be open. Of the "total initial claims" since March 1, some remain open and some are no longer active.

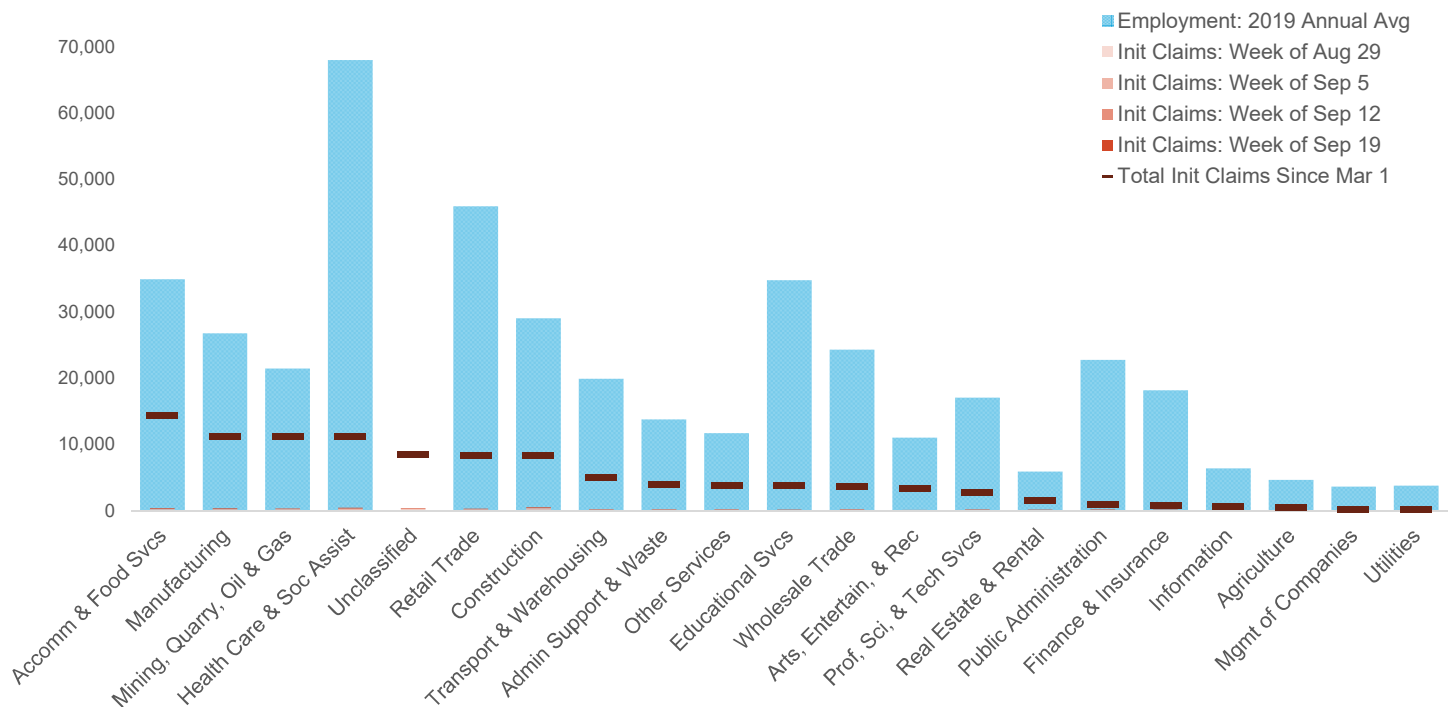

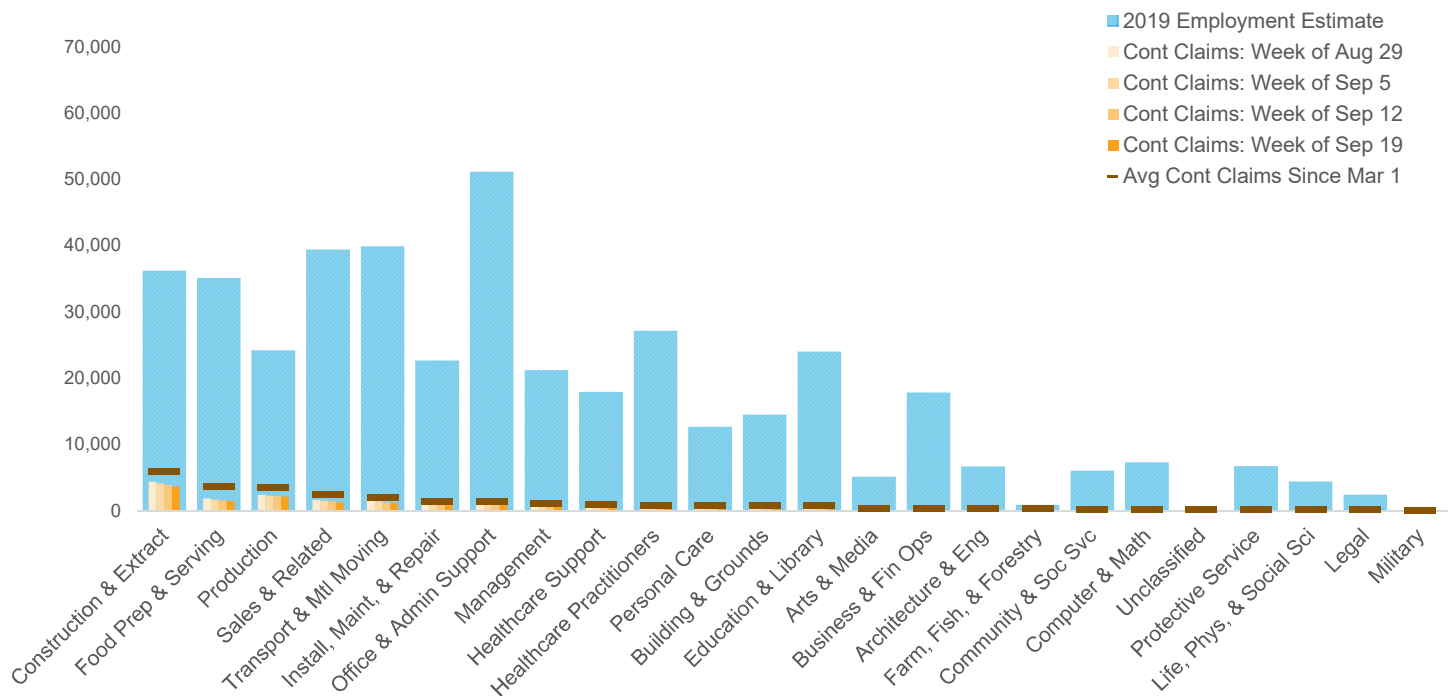

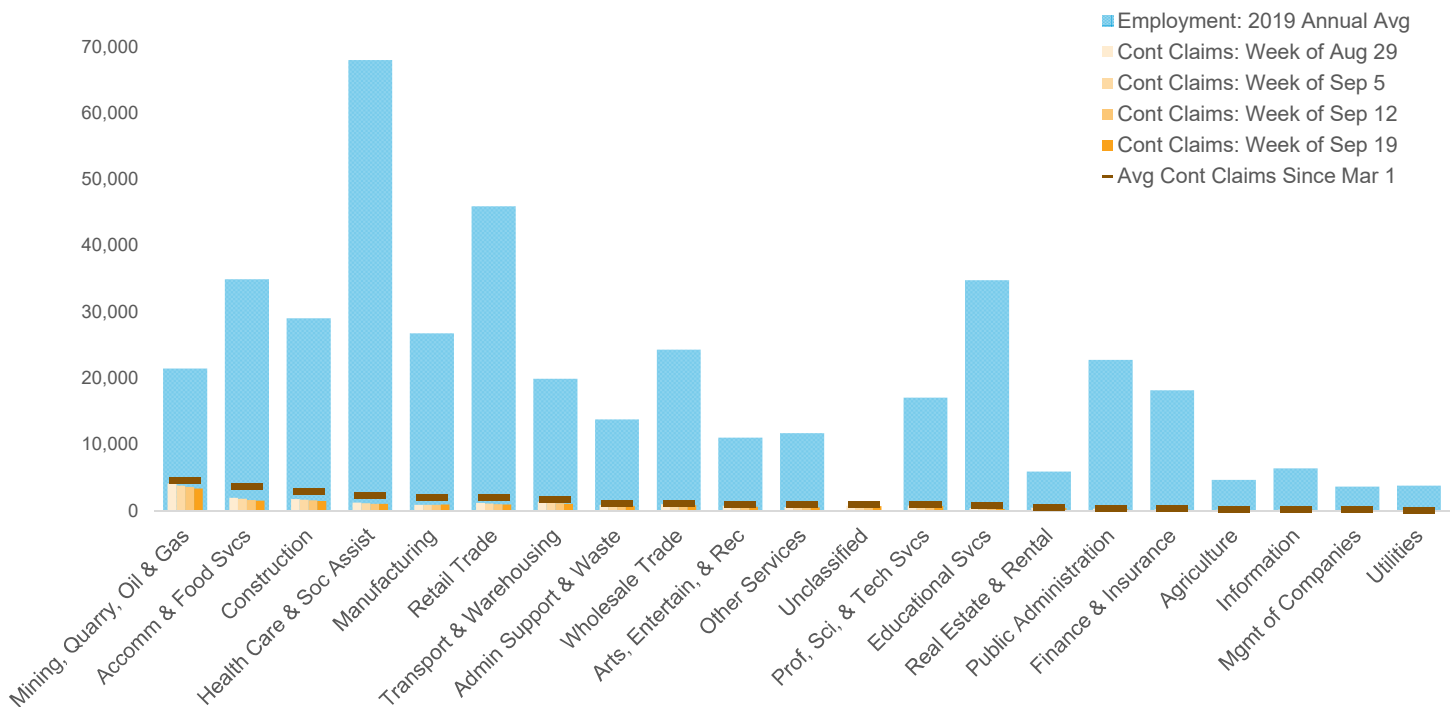
